An Intermediate short course for people experiencing homelessness, or affected by mental health, addiction or justice services

This course dives into storytelling with weekly focuses on character, dialogue, plot, and themes. Students will explore **mini sagas, poetry, journalism, imagery, and music-inspired writing**, practice creative exercises, and receive constructive feedback to written work. By the end, participants will have new tools to keep growing as confident, expressive writers.
